What the Fair Tax does

Current Tax System

Currently, everyone pays the same income tax rate, regardless of income.

For example, a billionaire pays the same income tax rate as a minimum wage worker

Fair Tax


The Fair Tax allows for higher rates for higher incomes and lower rates for people with low and moderate incomes.



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Why do we need Fair Tax reform?





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Illinois current tax system is unfair



- The bottom 20% of Illinois' earners have two times the tax burden of the wealthy
- The bottom 20% of Illinois' earners pay more than they would in any other Midwestern state



Illinois is in fiscal crisis

- The state has billions in unpaid bills, leaving Illinois' non-profits and businesses in a bind.
- Illinois has a structural deficit, meaning that if the state doesn't change tax policy or service levels, revenues will grow more slowly than spending each year.





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The current system is failing our state

Illinois State Budget Cuts, 2000-2019

Category	% Change
Higher Education	-52%
Healthcare	-22%
Human Services*	-29%
Public Safety	-21%

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Illinois' tax system is broken

- Illinois is 1 of only 4 states that mandates a flat tax in its constitution
- 32 states, D.C., and the Federal Government use a fair tax structure
- A fair tax helps create a more equitable tax system asking the wealthiest to pay their fair share while giving a break to the middle class and those struggling to get



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What does the Fair Tax mean for me?



With a Fair Tax, only those making at least \$250,000 a year will pay more

97% of taxpayers will receive some tax relief



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Proposed Fair Tax Rates

Single Filers

Income	Rate
\$0-10,000	4.75%
\$10,001-100,000	4.90%
\$100,001-250,000	4.95%
\$250,001-350,000	7.75%
\$350,001-750,000	7.85%
\$750,000+	7.99%*

Joint Filers

income	Rate
\$0-10,000	4.75%
\$10,001-100,000	4.90%
\$100,001-250,000	4.95%
\$250,001-500,000	7.75%
\$500,001-1,000.000	7.85%
\$1,000,000+	7.99%*

*This rate applies to the taxpayer's entire income.



The Fair Tax will fundamentally change the trajectory of our state

- The Fair Tax invests \$3 billion a year into schools, human services, and other critical state needs
- Illinois will finally be able to responsibly pay its bills
- We will address our structural budget deficit and break the constant cycle of fiscal crisis in Illinois



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How do we win the Fair Tax for Illinois?



The Fair Tax must be approved by voters in November 2020

A 'yes' vote of more than 50% of those voting in the election

A 'yes vote' of more than OR 60% of those voting on the question
